Public Works Report: Andrew Bean reported Flushed fire hydrants, park trail maintenance and mulch. Water reservoir is due for tank cleaning. Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr.Perrin to have water reservoir cleaned by Pittsburg Tank in the amount of \$7330.00.Unanimiosouly carried. DEP regulation to be done every three years. Getting the park ready for the upcoming SVFD annual festival. Working on Little league fields. Got pricing for solar speed signs.

Police Reports for the month-Not present

Correspondence: Progressive Insurance reached out with a pro-rated offer for replacing the fire hydrant that was damaged from motor vehicle accident summer 2025. Driver only varied limited liability. Council advised secretary to reach out to borough solicitor on recommendation on how to proceed due to lacking coverage to pay for cost of fire hydrant. Will Hunt with newly organized NRAT COG has scheduled a meeting with local townships and boroughs to discuss the possible future of the proposed route maps for the ATV/UTV trails and connections in boroughs and townships scheduled for June 26th. Received application with someone inquiring about possible part time police. Motion was made by Mr. Perrin and seconded by Mr. Donovan for preliminary interview and hire of applicant after reviewing current budget for part time police at the next monthly meeting. Unanimously carried.

Committee Reports: Mr. Resig stated he was told the borough Assembly Park looks nice. Mr. Resig called Weston Mills NY and Bolivar NY recycling companies regarding taking recycling materials from Pennsylvania. They both said they will not take and not permitted to take recycling materials from PA residents due to new law and regulations.

Motion was made by Mr. Milliken and seconded by Mr. Perrin to approve Pennvest payment request No. 14 funding number 71487 in the amount of \$461,653.05 includes Pennvest related interests costs and construction costs. Unanimously carried. Mr. Church abstained. Motion was made by Mr. Milliken and seconded by Mr. Donovan to approve pay app No. 10 for H&K GC in the amount of \$440,496.00 and Pay app No. 05 Dave Kronewetter EC in the amount of \$21,125.61 for Dave Unanimously carried. Mr. Barry Church abstained.

Motion was made by Mr. Donovan and seconded by Mr. Resig to adjourn the meeting at 8:04 PM. Unanimously carried.
